The Nursery Supervisor plays a vital role in advancing restoration and conservation efforts by overseeing daily nursery operations and producing high-quality, locally sourced native plants. This position works closely with the program leadership and regional partners to support habitat restoration throughout the Laguna Watershed, while also leading staff, interns, and volunteers—fostering a collaborative, inclusive environment that strengthens both community engagement and program impact.

- **Lead with Purpose:** Guide daily nursery operations that directly support habitat restoration, helping bring native landscapes back to life across the Laguna Watershed.
- **Inspire and Grow People:** Mentor and uplift staff, interns, and volunteers—creating a collaborative, inclusive environment where people and plants thrive together.
- **Cultivate Native Plant Life:** Support the propagation and care of locally sourced native plants, applying best practices to nurture healthy, resilient plant communities.
- **Strengthen Impact and Connection:** Support seed collection, track plant availability, and contribute to community engagement efforts that expand the reach and impact of restoration work.

The Laguna de Santa Rosa Foundation is a watershed-based 501(c)3 non-profit organization in Sonoma County. We work to restore and conserve the Laguna and its surrounding watershed, and to inspire appreciation of the vital wetland habitats and the plant and animal communities that rely on it.

This is a full-time position requiring 40 hours per week located in Santa Rosa, CA. Hourly pay range: \$23.25 - \$26. Eligible for participation in employer-sponsored health, dental, and vision insurance, accrued vacation, sick leave front-loaded annually, paid holidays, two paid personal days, and participation in 403(b) retirement plan.
